Two 40 gsm polyester film liners are used to maintain excellent adhesive clarity. This clear mounting film offers protection from UV, abrasion, moisture and other environmental exposures. This product is designed for laminating thin flexible films and papers under 254 mic in total thickness. It can be laminated by the cold laminating process without the addition of heat.
