- Rolls are wound Print Side Out (PSO).
- Suitable for printing with Latex, UV-C and Eco-Solvent printers.

Application

- Suitable for application to flat or slightly curved surfaces
- This product is not designed for application to low energy surfaces

- It is the responsibility of the user to determine the suitability of the material for the application.
- Test the application with a small piece of the material prior to doing the full application

Storage

- We recommend storing the material in its original tube and wrapping when not in use.
- Material can be stored for up to 12 months when stored in the original packaging
- Store between 20°C and 25°C at 50% relative humidity

Laminating

- Leave the inks to cure for between 24-48 hours before overlaminating. Latex inks can be laminated immediately.
- We recommend laminating this vinyl with VistaMAX*
